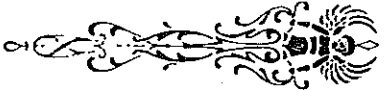


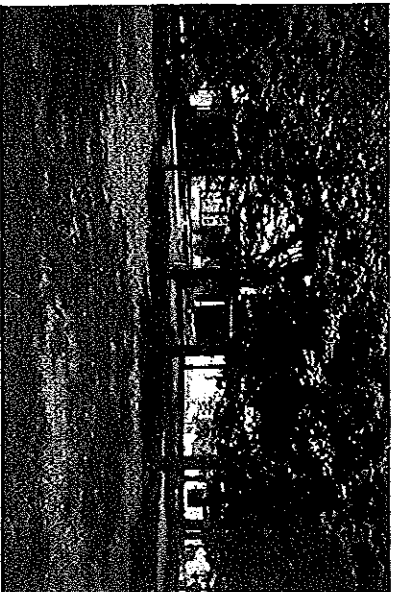
CENTRALLY LOCATED: Between Providence, R. I., Springfield and Worcester, Mass., and Willimantic, Conn.
